

CONTRIBUTION TO TRANSPORT PROFESSION AWARD

Aim of Award

This award is a personal award to recognise an individual who has made a significant contribution to the transport profession in Australia and New Zealand over a significant time.

The contribution to the profession may be in the areas of transport research, strategies, projects, programs, administration or education. It may be in the fields of traffic or transport engineering or transport planning.

Criteria

The award sub-committee will assess submissions according to the following criteria:

- Significant contribution to the community through endeavour in the transport profession
- Advancement in the practice of the transport profession
- Coverage of the nominee's contribution at the international or national level
- The number of years the nominee has been active in the profession
- Personal commitment
- Standing in the industry

Nominees do not have to be members of ITE.

Please provide at least two referees who can vouch for the nominee's contributions.
