programmes. Rose works for Mott MacDonald and has a significant

global profile in the travel planning industry as well as business

stakeholder engagement, behaviour change and transport planning

disciplines.

Rose will share her experience on how to Keep Cities Moving by implementing focused and intelligence led behaviour change programs. A concept she has rolled out for the London Olympics, Glasgow Commonwealth Games, and is currently working with the City of Gold Coast to deliver to support the 2018 Commonwealth Games.

We will also hear about how Rose and a Mott MacDonald transport planning team is supporting TfNSW in delivering a Travel Demand Management (TDM) Strategy to support Sydney to keep moving during the implementation of the light rail through the centre of the CBD. This is the first application of TDM of its kind to support a long term construction project.
