



EMERGING TRANSPORT PROFESSIONAL AWARD

Aim of Award

This award aims to recognize young transport professionals in Australia and New Zealand who have contributed to the advancement of the transportation profession and/or their community early in their career.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this award, nominees must be engineers and associated transport professionals who are under 35 years old.

Criteria

The criterion used to judge nominations is:

- Significance of their contribution to the advancement of the transportation profession and/or their community.

Contributions which are likely to resonate include (but are not limited to) the following. Compared with their peers, the nominee has:

- demonstrated leadership/management/community empathy qualities significantly in advance of their peers
- outstanding technical ability which has contributed significantly to improved project/program outcomes
- shown innovative thinking which has resulted in projects/programs taking a different direction and achieving successful outcomes which they otherwise wouldn't have
- made significant and regular contributions - formally or informally - to their profession or to the professional development of their colleagues
- demonstrated superior professional ethics when faced with difficult decisions or when tackling adverse positions
- the ability to bring people/communities/projects together in a way which creates total 'value' over and above the 'sum of the parts'.

Demonstrating superior organisational or business development abilities, in the above context, may also be considered.

Nominations

Candidates may nominate themselves or may be nominated by a senior work colleague. Self-nominees must provide at least one referee, ideally a person of long standing industry experience.

The submission should include:

- a brief (150-1000 words) rationale setting out the basis of the nomination
- any other contacts or referees who could provide more information
- contact details.

Nominations for the award will be judged and determined by a sub-committee made up of ITEANZ executive board members and other transport professionals.

Nominators and candidates should note that the sub-committee may make enquiries regarding the candidate's standing within the areas of expertise and experience which form the basis of the nomination.

ITE International Membership

All nominees must be financial members of ITE at the time of nomination or become ITE members before the award is granted. Fees are heavily discounted for young members: \$US30 per year up to age 24, then \$US60 at age 25 increasing to the full rate at age 30.
