Application Requirements

1. Cover letter, outlining

- a. Contact details
- b. Why you want to attend the Annual Meeting
- c. Your interest in transport engineering
- d. Proposed dates of travel
- e. Budget and Acknowledgement of self-funding contribution required (refer to 'indicative expense)
- f. A declaration of any other financial support for attending the Meeting
- 2. CV

3. Proof of membership

4. Response to selection criteria

- a. Overview of involvement in the ITE (past)
- b. Benefits of attending & age
 - i. For ITE
 - ii. For Student





Responses to selection criteria should include examples of the outreach the applicant proposes to undertake to realise these benefits. Some examples are listed below:

Suggested Outreach Activities

- 1. Preparatory activities (leading up to the Annual Meeting)
- Register for student leadership summit
- Visit <u>ITE online</u> and explore publications (ITE Spotlite, <u>ITE Journal</u>) and the <u>ITE Learning Hub</u>, to get a sense of the resources that ITE offers
- <u>Subscribe for council updates</u> and consider attending one or two council meetings on the weekend prior to the conference
- Explore the conference schedule
- Consider making contact with ITE members who you may have the opportunity to meet at the Annual meeting
