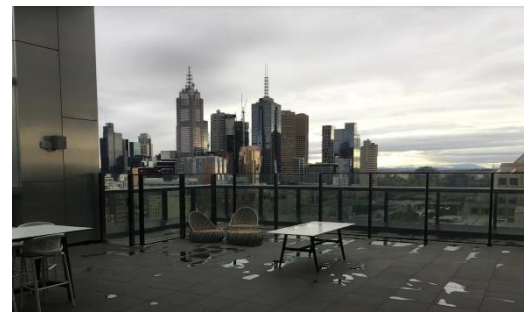


Guest Speakers
