



# Sustainable Transport Award

## Aim of Award

The ITE-ANZ will make an award to recognise an individual or organisation that has made a significant contribution to sustainable transport through research, strategy, program, project or advocacy which encourages, promotes or provides facilities for sustainable transport (walking, cycling and public transport).

## Criteria

The criteria used to judge nominations are:

- Significance of the contribution to the sustainability and liveability of community through effective transport research, strategies, projects, programs or advocacy.
- The contribution may be directed at:
  - reducing transportation impacts on climate change
  - enhancing the resilience of transport systems and the communities they serve
  - improving mass transit services
  - reducing car dependency
  - stimulating sustainable economic growth.
- Whether the work has been adopted, demonstrated or tested in the community.
- Transferability of the work to other jurisdictions.
- How effectively the work has addressed technical, financial, political and social issues.

## Nomination

Nominations for the award will be judged and determined by a sub-committee made up of ITE-ANZ executive board members and other transport professionals.

To nominate, please describe in less than 2,000 words, the research, strategy or project and how it has addressed the above criteria and contributed to sustainable transport.

The winner of this award will be required to present a seminar on their work.
