It is estimated that there are about 8 membership applications under consideration at this stage. The distribution by agency/state not known.

Discussion

The above figures show that the highest percentage of the membership is from Victoria, particularly from government authorities. There is a low percentage in other states (except NSW), with a very low representation from municipal councils across Australia, given the number of traffic engineers employed.

It would be desirable to have a regular increase in membership (say, 10% per year) with emphasis directed to particular groups.

A membership strategy for 1986 is considered necessary to cover the Committee's intention on increasing membership, effort required and direction.
