ITE-ANZ Treasurer's Annual Report 2021

This report covers the ITE-ANZ Section Inc. financial year which operates from 1st January 2021 to 31st December 2021. In addition to this summary, it includes three spreadsheets: the Balance Sheet, Profit and Loss and Cash Summary. All of these spreadsheets include 2021 and the previous four years for comparison. Information is presented on a cash basis and excludes GST, except where shown.

This year's financials have again been influenced by COVID, materialising primarily in the reduction of expenses. ITE-ANZ's balance sheet has grown again this year. Income is largely consistent with previous years and cost of sales is generally consistent with 2020 after accounting for timing differences (see Note 2a).

Notes:

- 1. Sponsorship at \$22,000 remains our major source of income, followed by event fees (i.e. event sales) of \$10,931, and \$208 in interest.
 - a. SIDRA sponsorship for the 2021 dinner is expected in 2022.
 - b. Event fees (sales) are comparable to 2020, with lower ticket sales for the Breakfast and higher ticket sales for the Dinner in 2021.
- 2. Most expenditure was on event costs (\$10,735) followed by award costs of \$8,629. Total cost of sales was \$19,364, a \$5,717 increase from 2020.
 - a. Increase in event costs is attributed to increased cost of venue hire for the Annual Dinner (due to increased attendance compared to 2020) and timing differences for the Annual Breakfast venue hire (in 2020 this was split 50/50 between the 2019 and 2020 financial year whereas in 2021 this was all captured in the financial year).
 - b. The Emerging Professional of the Year Award is a new award (\$1000 inc. GST) that was awarded this year.
 - c. No Worldwide Learning Opportunity (WWLO) grants were awarded this year.
- 3. Overall, a profit of 39% income was recorded in 2021.
- 4. A GST payment of \$73 is calculated for the final quarter of 2021. This will be reflected in the 2022 financial statements.
- 5. The President's Dinner and Annual Breakfast both returned a profit.
- 6. The Total Equity, shown on the Balance Sheet, increased from \$56,207 in 2020 to \$68,973 in 2021.
